

**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONAL CALENDAR DATES
2019 SUMMER SEMESTER**

Full Session: May 28 – August 06, 2019

(50 Instructional Days)

- May 09 All students should have their Student Aid Report and related paperwork in the Office of Financial Aid by this date to avoid delay in clearing of fees on Pell Grant for the 2019 Summer Semester.
- May 23-24 New & returning student REGISTRATION
- May 23-24 Faculty Duty Days
- May 27 HOLIDAY - Memorial Day (College Closed)
- May 28 First day of Classes, 2019 Summer Semester
- May 28-29 LATE REGISTRATION (Requires \$25.00 penalty) and Faculty Duty
- May 29 Last Day to Add/Drop Full Semester or First Mini-Session Classes
- Jun 28 - Jul 01 Registration for Second Mini-Session Classes
- July 01 The 50% point (mid-point) of the Full Semester. Grades of 'I' from the 2019 Spring term change to grades of 'F.'
- July 02 **Final grades for all First Mini-Session prerequisite courses (e.g., ENG 101, ENG 102) are due in the Dean of Students' Office not later than 10:00a.m.**
- July 04 HOLIDAY - Independence Day (College Closed)
- July 10 The 61% point of the Full Semester. There is no Title IV (Pell Grant) penalty for withdrawal after this date.
- July 23 The 80% point of the Full Semester. The Last day to withdraw from any course for any reason without penalty and receive a grade of 'W.'
- Aug 05-6 Final Exams for Full Semester and Second Mini-Session Courses
- Aug 06 End of 2019 Summer Semester
- Aug 07 **Final grades for all Full Session and all Mini-Session courses are due in the Dean of Students' Office not later than 10:00a.m.**
