

Associate Degree Nursing: Mobility Program

NUR 209. Concepts for Healthcare Transition Students. 10 hours

PREREQUISITE: Admission to nursing program

This course focuses on application of nursing concepts to assist health care professionals to transition into the role of the registered nurse. Emphasis in this course is placed on evidenced based clinical decision making and nursing concepts provided in a family and community context for a variety of health alterations across the lifespan.

NUR 211. Advanced Nursing Concepts. 7 hrs

PREREQUISITE: Successful completion of NUR 114, NUR 115, PSY 200 and BIO 220

COREQUISITES: PSY 210, SPH 106 OR 107

Course Description: This course provides opportunities for students to integrate advanced nursing care concepts within a family and community context.

NUR 221. Advanced Evidence Based Clinical Reasoning.

PREREQUISITE: Successful completion of NUR 211, PSY 210 and SPH 106 or 107

COREQUISITES: Approved Humanities Elective

Course Description: This course provides students with opportunities to demonstrate graduate competencies through didactic and preceptorship experiences necessary to transition to the profession of nursing. Content includes various topics within the nursing and health care domains.
